

APTA WASHINGTON DELEGATE JOB DESCRIPTION

Purpose: The policy defines the qualifications and responsibilities of the Physical Therapist Delegates.

Background: The source of the job responsibility policy is the APTA Washington Bylaws Article IX, Section 9.01 and 9.02.

Qualifications:

(A) Only Physical Therapist members who have been Association members for no fewer than

two (2) years immediately preceding the start of the House of Delegates may serve as Physical Therapist delegates.

Rights and Duties:

- (A) All Physical Therapist Delegates:
 - (1) Shall represent the Chapter on such matters as are ordered by the Chapter Board of Directors or membership and vote by voice or ballot. In case of a temporary indisposition of the Chief Delegate attending the House of Delegates, an acting Chief Delegate may be elected by those delegates attending the session.
 - (2) Shall attend all sessions of the House of Delegates and other meetings as determined by the Chief Delegate.
